**Children (Infants- 5th grade) - The Net:
Casting "The Net" to hook kids on Jesus!**

The Net is our new children's Sunday School program using the Workshop Rotation Model, where children rotate to a different area each week experiencing the unit theme in a new, exciting way! Now through Feb. 22, the children are learning about Jesus at the Synagogue. From March 1 - Apr. 12 (Easter), they will have a Lenten study about Peter.

Sunday's Schedule

9:45-10:45 AM - Nursery: Infants-2 yr. olds

9:45-10:00 AM - Ages 3yrs.- 5th grade gather in The Fish Tank for music.

10-10:45 AM - The Wiggly Worms (ages 3 - preK) go with their leader to their regular classroom. They are introduced to Bible stories using age-appropriate curriculum.

10-10:45 AM - Elementary aged children stay with their "Fishing Guides" for their current rotation. Minnows (K-2nd) and Anglers (3rd-5th) will rotate to a different station each week to experience a new aspect of the Bible theme. Rotations include Creation Cove (art), Seaside Sermon (story/drama), God's Galley (cooking), Dockside Discovery (science), Rod-and-Reel Theater (movie), Go Fish (games), and The Tackle Box (missions).

Parents must sign in their children and pick them up at 10:45. Infants may stay.

Sunday Mornings

Everyone is invited to the Central Café for coffee and pastries at 9:30 AM in the fellowship hall. Along with our children's classes, we also offer a variety of adult classes and a youth class from 10:00-10:45 AM.

Adults

Rowe-Henry - A Biblical studies class of mostly older adults. Where: Rowe-Henry room, top floor of Education Building between the Pastor's study & the Minister of Discipleship's office.

Koinonia - A class of mostly middle-aged adults seeking to find community around God's Word for their lives. Starting February: A 13 week study on Proverbs.

Where: Koinonia room, beside Rowe-Henry (see above)

Not There Yet - A class of 30s - middle-aged adults applying Biblical principles to real life issues. Where: Parlor, top floor Education Bldg. across from the kitchen.

Young Adult - This class is for those out of high school but not yet 30. February's topic: United Methodist Views and Beliefs. Where: Back end of fellowship hall.

Handbells - This adult group practices handbells to play during worship. Where: Handbell room, follow hall next to the elevator in the Education Building.

"The New Class" - We hope to start this class March 1 pending leadership. It is for all adult ages and will use the Serendipity Bible Study. Where: Multi-purpose room. Look for more information in the newsletter.

Youth

Youth Sunday School - Middle school & High School youth discuss issues to build a life of faith. Where: Youth room, across from fellowship hall.

Confirmation Class - Youth 6th grade and older who wish to join the church meet in David's office during Sunday School.
