## BLESSING BOX AND BAGKPAGK MINISTRY UPDATE

Thank you for your support of these 2 greatly needed and used ministries! Please continue to bring canned pasta (Chef Boyardee microwavable cups), non-perishable foods, and toiletry items. The backpack ministry serves 62 kids each week at North Canton Elementary. The blessing box is used daily. The backpack ministry will take a break over the summer but we anticipate the need for the blessing box to increase over the summer when kids are no longer receiving school breakfasts and lunches. Currently we are in urgent need of canned food and other types of hearty food for the blessing box. We have been blessed with other items currently but we are running low on "filling foods" such as canned soups, canned pastas such as Chef Boyardee, canned tunas and chicken, pork and beans, ramen noodles, etc.
The box is currently being restocked an average of 4 times a week and each day we go to refill it, it is near empty. If you could help us build back up our backstock of items for this greatly needed and used ministry we would be so appreciative of it. Thank you!
